

Scholarship Requirements

C Major 7 Music Center of Chicago is offering 50% scholarships to 3 new violin students, 1 new piano student, and 1 new vocal student.

All candidates or guardians must submit the signed and dated Scholarship Application, attend an audition/interview and submit a letter of Intent (details are below).

Students must attend weekly lessons, practice weekly, complete weekly practice assignments, promote/invite/sell tickets to fundraisers and other performances and perform in the concerts/recitals requested by the teacher. Scholarships may be revoked and rewarded to another candidate after 3 unexcused or frequent absences.

Criteria for Scholarship

If candidate is 12 years or younger, parent or guardian must submit a letter of intent (double spaced, 12pt font) to C Major 7 Music Center expressing:

- Why they want to take lessons
- · Any previous musical experience of the student.

Parent or guardian must attend all lessons and insure that the student practices weekly and show progress.

If candidate is 13 - 18 years of age, they must submit a letter of intent (double spaced, 12pt font) to C Major 7 Music Center expressing:

- Any previous musical experience
- Why they want to take lessons

Parent or guardian of students must insure that the student practices weekly and show progress.

All students will be asked to purchase music books that will be used in their weekly lessons (approximately \$30)

Beginning Students ONLY (maximum 2 years of experience)

students will be asked:

To follow provide a vocal demonstration or to follow a demonstration on the violin or piano Questions about information submitted in their application packet

Material required to practice at home will be identity by the instructor.

Recipient of the scholarship must perform in scheduled performances by the teacher. Any fundraisers that the recipient participates in, they must sell 5 tickets at the suggested donation price.
